

New Mexico Tuition Scholarship Appeal Form

Students who have unforeseen extenuating circumstances that prevented them from meeting the requirements for New Mexico Tuition Scholarships are eligible to submit an appeal. Appeals are reviewed by the Office of Financial Aid. Submission of an appeal form does not guarantee approval.

Appeal form must include:

- 1. Detailed personal typed statement explaining:
 - a. details of the extenuating circumstances to include: dates the circumstance occurred and the duration of the circumstance and how it affected your ability to complete course work
 - b. plan of action to help ensure successful meeting of the requirements in the future
- 2. Pertinent documentation to support the appeal such as letters from official personnel or appropriate authorities, doctor statements, court documents, etc.

Request for a credit hour exemption during graduating semester or program curriculum restrictions. An appeal can be submitted for a credit hour exemption if:

- o a student is scheduled to graduate and is in their last semester of coursework and/or
- o coursework is limited due to program curriculum

Students in these situations will complete applicable items on this form and submit a statement regarding their graduation status and/or coursework limitation along with a copy of their degree plan. The degree plan must be signed by an advisor and the student. Remaining courses needed for graduation should be highlighted and the student must be enrolled in these specific courses.

- Students who are unable to start their college education within the required timeline due to Military or Religious Service must notify the WNMU Office of Financial Aid prior to their delayed qualifying semester and include documentation of service (example:DD-214 for Military).
